Kenya Safari Brief

Kenya Wildlife Safari October 01, 2026



Nairobi

Our starting and ending point is the Kenya Capital of Nairobi. While in Nairobi we will enjoy two visits. The first visit is to the Giraffe Center. In 1979, Jock Leslie Melville, the Kenyan grandson of a Scottish Earl, and his wife Betty realized the Rothschild Giraffes were drastically declining in numbers. The Melville's captured two baby giraffes to start a giraffe breeding program on their property, today's site of the present Centre.

Since then, the program has had huge success, resulting in the introduction of several breeding pairs of Rothschild Giraffe into Kenyan national parks. Following our visit Ron arranged a Surprise Visit in which we journey back in time. TBA. Following our second visit we will enjoy a wonderful group lunch before returning to our hotel.

Aberdare Mountains

The mountain range is located in the central Kenya and lies just south of the Equator. Our accommodation is set in the heart of the Aberdare National Park, which overlooks a floodlit waterhole and salt lick, which attracts a host of awesome wildlife.

You will enjoy the comings and goings of the wildlife. here are multitudes of Elephant, Buffalo, Giant Forest Hog, Hyena as well as the Endangered Black Rhino and Bongo. A variety of cats including Leopards, Servals, Civet, Genet and the rare African Golden Cat. Other threatened species including the Jackson Mongoose, the Black and White Colobus Monkey and Sykes' Monkey are plentiful, as are Waterbuck, Reedbuck, Duikers, and Bushbuck.

Amboseli National Park (Mt. Kilimanjaro)

Amboseli National Park is in southern Kenya. It's known for its large elephant herds and views of immense Mount Kilimanjaro, across the border in Tanzania. Observation Hill offers panoramas of the peak and the park's plains and swamps. Varied wildlife includes Giraffes, Zebras, Cheetahs and hundreds of bird species.

The western section is dominated by vast Lake Amboseli, which is dry outside the rain. It is in this park that we try to see the famous impressive elephants, which are the last of this gene pool that boasting massive tusks. You will be amazed by these highly endangered "Tusker" elephants.

Lake Naivasha

This freshwater lake is home to a variety of types of wildlife including over 400 different species of birds and a sizable population of hippos. Joy Adamson (Born Free), lived on the shores of the lake in the mid-1960s.

Lake Nakuru National Park

The lake's abundance of algae used to attract a vast quantity of both Lesser and Greater Flamingos that famously lined the shore. You will see Warthogs, Baboons and other large mammals including the Endangered Rothschild's giraffe. Eastern Black Rhinos and Southern White Rhinos. There is a myriad of bird species that inhabit the lake, such as African Fish Eagle, Goliath Heron, and Pied Kingfisher among others.

Masai Mara (the Northern Serengeti)

Maasai Mara National Reserve is an area of preserved savannah wilderness in southwestern Kenya, along the Tanzanian border.

All members of the "Big Five" (Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Cape Buffalo, Black and White Rhinos) are found here all year round. In addition we be watching Spotted Hyenas, African Wild Dogs, Black-backed Jackals, African Striped Weasels, Caracals, Servals, Side-striped Jackals, Bat-eared Foxes, Otters, Impalas, Duikers, Coke's Hartebeests, Masai Giraffe, Vultures, Marabou Storks, Secretary Birds, Hornbills, Crowned Cranes, Ostriches, and the Lilac-Breasted Roller, which is the national bird of Kenya.

What is the best time to go on safari in Kenya?

With 35 years of conducting safaris Ron's personal choice for a safari experience is the end of May to the middle of June or the month of October. Not only is the weather enjoyable but you will avoid the massive crowds. July, August & September is the high season and therefore this time period should be avoided.
