# Tanzania Safari Brief



### Safari Capital Arusha (Tanzania)

Arusha is a city in East Africa's Tanzania, located at the base of volcanic Mt. Meru. It's a gateway to safari destinations and to Africa's highest peak, 5,895m Mt. Kilimanjaro

Arrival in Arusha at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO). Our group transfer to our accommodation will be less than an hour.

The following day, we will enjoy an Arusha City Sightseeing Tour, a visit to Burka Coffee Plantation, one of the oldest and largest Tanzania coffee farms. Our guided visit to the plantation showcases the coffee production process from coffee bean planting to the final cup. Ron always enjoys buying coffee to take home to Canada.

Following the tour, we will enjoy a wonderful group lunch before returning to our accommodation.

### Tarangire National Park

The Park got its name from Tarangire River that flows through the center of the park. The river is the primary source of fresh water for wild animals in the Tarangire Ecosystem during the annual dry season.

It is in this park that visitors will be able to see threatened as well as endangered species such as ebony trees, Python, cheetah, elephants, African wild dogs, lesser and greater Kudu, Beisa Oryx, Gerenuk and others. Birdlife in Tarangire is just Amazing! About 550 species of birds have been recorded in the park, which is a larger number of bird species than the famous Serengeti.

The giant Baobab Tree is another unique feature that can prevalently be seen in Tarangire. The baobab is referred to as the Tree of Life. It is 'gigantic' in nature and can store 300 liters to 1000 liters of water in its trunk. They have a long-life span and can survive for up to six hundred years.

### Lake Manyara

Well known for the tree climbing Lions, the soda ash lake that attracts thousands of Pink Flamingos, one of Tanzania's biggest Elephant population and breathtaking scenery!

The park has a soda ash lake that attracts thousands of pink flamingos (it depends on the alkalinity of the lake at the time). However, the main attraction is Lake Manyara's famous tree climbing Lions - why these Lions habitually climb trees is still up for debate, but viewing a pride relaxing in an acacia tree is a remarkable sight!

The park is also famous for its Elephant and huge number of Baboons, and its varied landscape supports an impressive range of other game which includes Wildebeest, Buffalo, Hippo, Zebra, Warthog, Waterbuck, Giraffe, Dik-Dik, Impala and breathtaking scenery. The birding here is also very good, especially raptors.

### Serengeti National Park

We will explore the endless Serengeti plains dotted with trees and kopjes (a small hill in a generally flat area). Serengeti National Park is a World Heritage Site teeming with wildlife: over 2 million ungulates (a hoofed mammal), 4000 Lions, 1000 leopards (the largest lion population in Africa), 550 Cheetahs and some 500 Bird Species inhabit an area.

The Serengeti is well known for the largest annual animal migration in the world of over 1.5 million Blue Wildebeest and 250,000 Zebra. In the Serengeti during May, you'll primarily see the Great Migration in action, with herds of wildebeest and other animals moving across the park's central and western regions.

### Ngorongoro Crater

The Ngorongoro Conservation Area is a protected area and a UNESCO World Heritage Site located within the Crater Highlands geological area of northern Tanzania. The area is named after Ngorongoro Crater, a large volcanic caldera within the area.

Large mammals in the crater include the black rhinoceros, the African Buffalo or Cape Buffalo and the Hippopotamus. There also Blue Wildebeest, Grant's Zebra, Eland, and both Grant's and Thomson's Gazelles, and Waterbucks.

Serval is a wild cat native to Africa and can be seen in the volcano crater. Lake Magadi, a large lake in the southwest of the crater, is often inhabited by thousands of mainly Lesser Flamingoes. The crater has one of the densest known populations of lions.

**Our Departure:** The day following our Ngorongoro Crater safari we will travel back to our starting point, Arusha where we will enjoy a Group Farewell Lunch and then check into dayrooms where we have a change to freshen an/or repack prior to heading back to the Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO).
